

Membership Fees S.A. Proto

This document contains the membership fees for Study Association Proto.

Policy By OS

According to the policy declared by the Organization of Study associations (OS), as voted in the General Member Assembly of May 31st, 2018, the membership fee for the following members are as follows:

- *A primary member pays between €8.50 and €10 per year to be a member of their association.*
- *A secondary member pays between €4.25 and €5 per year to be a member of their association.*

These are rules that we as a member of the OS need to follow.

Primary Members

In the statutes primary members are noted as 'ordinary members' of the association.

These 'ordinary members' are described as *all students of the bachelor Creative Technology at the University of Twente, and students which have successfully ended the bachelor Creative Technology and still are students of the aforementioned university.*

During the 21st GMM the membership fee for **primary members was determined to be €10, -.**

During the 29th GMM the membership fee for **Interaction Technology students was determined to be €10, -.** This is because there are still activities organised for the master students.

Secondary Members

In the statutes secondary members are noted as 'associate members' of the association.

These 'associate members' are described as *Staff at the University of Twente, they who are registered as student at aforementioned University and are not of the bachelor Creative Technology, Former students or former staff at the aforementioned University, All other persons who in any other way show an interest in the objectives of the association.*

During the 21st GMM the Membership fee for **secondary members was determined to be €5, -.**

Alumni Discount

During the 21st GMM the alumni discount of Creative Technology alumni was determined, which results in alumni paying the same as secondary members, which means that **alumni pay €5, -.**

The alumni discount is for people that have successfully ended Creative Technology as of now.

This means that CreaTe students studying I Tech still get the alumni discount.

Benefactors

In the statutes Benefactors are noted as 'ordinary members' of the association.

These 'ordinary members' are described as *those persons, who financially support the Association with a minimum annual contribution to be determined by the General Meeting, and who are not members.*

During the 1st GMM the minimal fee for **benefactors was determined to be €15, -.**

Honorary Members

Now, nothing is set for an honorary member to pay, so there is **no minimal and no maximum amount for an honorary members** to pay to the association.
